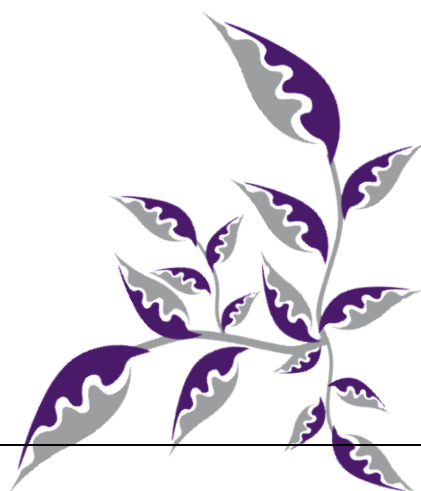

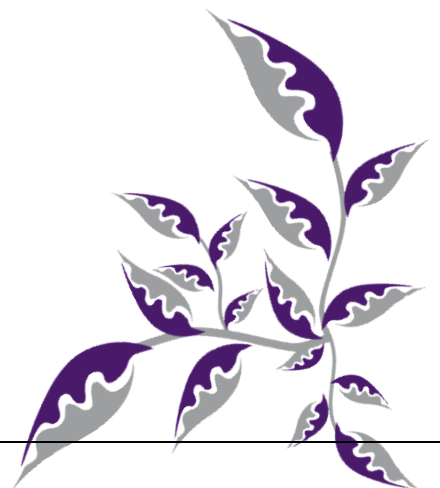

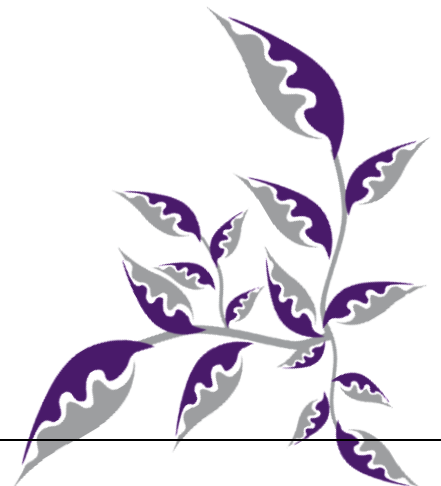

College Principal's 2013 Report: Mr Chris Eeles

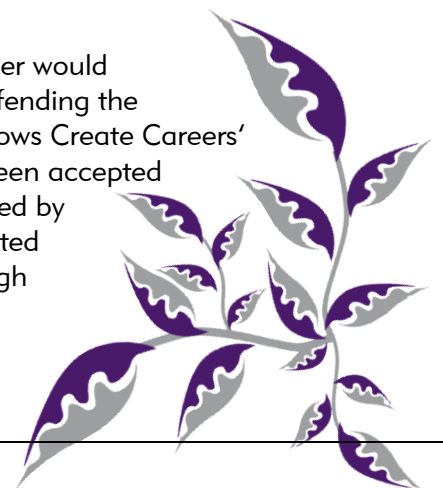
Echuca College continues to work for the students and the families of Echuca and district and like the world around us the College has changed significantly since its establishment in 2006. I would however like to thank our community for the support given to our students and staff during the year. In addition, I would like to acknowledge the efforts of our students and wish those students leaving the College all the best for the future. To our graduating Year 12 class, well done and although you can sit back and enjoy the fruits of your labour for a few weeks, life for you is just beginning; embrace it and live it to its full. I would also like to acknowledge the great work of our teachers and education support staff.

We started the year with our 2012 students performing very well, achieving some of the best results the College has experienced since its establishment. Our Dux Jaklyn Crilly (97.45) was the highest in Echuca and surrounding schools, our VCE All Study score was (mean) 29, English 27.9, Specialist Maths 33 and score of >40 at 5.4%. All these scores were better than other schools in Echuca and the immediate area. The College saw improvement from previous year's results in almost half its VCE subjects and the improvement adds to a five year trend of improvement in our VCE results. Congratulations to our students and teachers on a great result.

In mid-January, the 'Class of 2012' received their University and TAFE offers. We had 60 students apply through VTAC with 92% receiving a first round offer and 82% receiving either their first or second preference. In December 2012, 32 students received "Early Offers" to universities in Victoria and NSW. A number of students have received scholarships. Students are still receiving offers as universities work their way through their selection process well into February. As an example of the opportunities offered to the 'Class of 2012, Echuca College students are now studying Science-Honours at Australian National University (Canberra) and Physiotherapy at Charles Sturt University. One student was offered the opportunity to study either Veterinary Science or Pharmacy and has chosen to pursue a Career in Pharmacy. Students have received offers in a broad range of University courses at both Melbourne and Regional campuses; including Biomedical Science, Architecture, Film and Media, Zoology, Chiropractic, Occupational Therapy, Engineering, and Surveying. We also have a number of students involved in Education, Nursing and the Health Sciences. The College is very proud of the achievements of our Year12s and the various vocations and courses they are now accessing. I would like to thank Mr Webb, Mrs Morrison and the VCE team that worked with students to successfully put these opportunities in place for our students.

Our curriculum supports a comprehensive list of subjects and programs, plus the College continues to support the district's students through the provision of VET Certificates. Again, many extra curricula activities are initiated from these programs and provide our students with experiences not often available to others. This year we had two great tours happen in term three. Students travelled to Malaysia/Singapore and through central Australia to Darwin. In December, a group of Year 12 students have again ventured to Cambodia to work in local schools and to help with the construction of buildings to support education in this country; a much better option than 'schoolies'. VCAL students kept us fuelled up with great coffee and cakes all year as they completed Barista training in our Café Learning Area. Our Arts Exhibition show cased senior students creatively once again. Congratulations to the students who participated in the Echuca Winter Blues Festival's - Blues Boot Camp this year. The students involved included first and second year VET Music students. Students from the Boot Camp performed their songs to packed crowds at Radcliffe's. Debating has been a successful area at the College over the years and in 2013 our senior debating team of Tegan Milne, Jess Hardess and Kayla Arkinstall competed against students from Kyabram P-12 for the Apex Club's, 'Cootes Family Perpetual Trophy'.

Our team had to defend the affirmative position that 'Performance for teacher would enhance student outcomes'. I'm proud to say our team was successful in defending the affirmative position. Congratulations to our Year 11 student who won the 'Cows Create Careers' Competition for the northern region. Year 11 student Hayley Barnard has been accepted into the National Mathematics Summer School, her application was supported by her Mathematics Methods teacher Ms Carroll. Hayley is one of only 60 selected from across Australia. Timothy Denson of Year 9, achieved the award of High Distinction, awarded to students who scored in the top 1% of the state in Mathematics, a truly outstanding effort. Echuca College won the best film



promoting immunization in 'Loddon Mallee Department of Health/DEECD Immunization' film competition. The film was created by; Emma Favalaro, Courtney Johnson and Maegan Johnson who will all be awarded \$666 each. The competition formed part of the "Get Immunised – it does save lives" campaign and aims to promote immunization awareness amongst adolescents. Our students completed in a number of individual events during the year sometimes self-nominated but often supported by our teachers. Kayla Arkinstall has been selected to attend the National Youth Science Forum in Perth in January 2014. Six Year 9 Student Leaders attended the Leadership School at Marlo for 8 weeks, Tyanah Case, Maegan and Courtney Johnson, Aron Pavone, Ashley Twigg and Jason Hanson. Our College Captain Brent McGrath was one of ten students nationally to receive an Excellence Award from Youth Links Australia, only to back this up with a VCAA VCE Leadership award getting into the last 8 students in the state.

Echuca College's 'Sports Specialist School' program continues to support our students' ambitions in the field of elite sport and this year we have seen some great individual and team achievements. Our senior girls' soccer team took off the top prize, winning the state final in Melbourne in the Schools Sports Victoria Final. Regan More's sporting achievements this year include; Winner Team Tennis Winter AMT, Semi Finalist in the SOLINCO September Shoot Out AMT, Round 16 Bendigo Junior Open and Association Championships. Congratulations to the Echuca College Junior Boys Hockey Team on winning the Loddon Mallee Region Hockey Competition. At the School Sport Victoria 2013 Secondary Track and Field Finals, Siobhan Thompson won gold in the Girls U/16 Discus and came 4th in the Girls U/16 Javelin. Asher Jones won silver in the Boys U/12-13 100 meters and won bronze in the Boys U/12-U/13 200 metres. Isaac Warren won bronze in the Boys U/14 100m and came fourth in the 200m; he was also part of the U/14 Boys Relay team who came fourth in the final. Kiennan Jones came sixth in the Boys U/18-20 200m. Loddon Mallee Regional Athletics our students who won gold and qualified for the state finals include the U/14 boys relay - Oscar Reid, Amos Farrell, Max Ogilvie and Isaac Warren. The boys broke the 2004 record held by Flora Hill. Isaac Warren won gold in the U/14 boys 100m and 200m and Asher Jones in the U/13 boys 100m and 200m. Kiennan Jones won gold in the U/21 boys 200m and Siobhan Thompson won gold in the U/16 girl's javelin and discus. Erik Holt-Crossman won silver in the U/16 boys 1500m and has also qualified for the state finals. Year 10 student Jessica Pitts travelled to China during the September holiday to represent Australia at the Asian Football Confederation Junior Women's Championships. Congratulations to Dylan Robertson who took out the North East Zone Clay Target shoot in Echuca. Dylan shot 19/20; he had the outright best score out of 230 shooters from a number of different schools. Congratulations to our U/ 14s boys Cross Country Team, 2nd at the State Finals. The team consisted of Oscar Reid, Liam Gundry, Max Ogilvie, Isaac Warren and Ben Hercott, a fantastic effort. Congratulations also to Jessica Davidson who placed 33rd overall in the Under 13 girls' event. Other sporting achievements include some great results at the State swimming carnival in Melbourne. Isaac Duffy won three bronze medals in the 'Students with Disabilities section U/12-15', our Girls U/20 relay team won silver, Tessa Mellington, Greta Pearson, Mardi-Lee Hutchins and Isabella Reid and our boys U/15 relay team won- silver; Oscar Reid, Luke Judd, Kyle Scott and Keegan Hutchins.

The College's work with our community continued in 2013. The College hosted the CCLLEN Expo in September in our stadium with over 50 activities/stalls on display for students from across the district to experience. Over 1500 students visited the Expo on the day. 'Work on Wheels,' supported by the Beacon Foundation, continued to be a great activity for our students. Mock interviews give our young people a chance to discuss their career options with members of the business community, while experiencing a job interview. There was an impressive range of interviewers in this year's program and their feedback has been very positive, reflecting the importance placed on having the interviews by students, teachers and local employers.

Echuca College together with 208 Primary and the Echuca Special School celebrated the 'National Day of Action Against Bullying and Violence' by taking a stand and participating in a number of activities including spelling out NO WAY using all the students to outline the message on the oval.

Echuca College also has linked up with Gunbower Primary School to learn Indonesian. This partnership developed from the need for Gunbower Primary to acquire an Indonesian teacher and the opportunity it provided Echuca College to test the technology. Once a week Echuca College link up via video link, using the polycom TV and Mrs Umbers (Ms Peters) teaches as many as 10-13 grade 5 and 6 students Indonesian. A great benefit to all involved.



Communication with our community is important in developing strong relationships between the College and families and the College and surrounding communities. We are also conscious of the need for our communications to be clear and up-to-date. The College successfully trialed a new approach to delivering information traditionally found in our newsletter via our website home page. On the website is a section called Echuca College News Feed and this site will be updated each time a new item of importance occurs at the College. Echuca College also launched an 'App' to support the Echuca College community. The College 'Dashboard' and electronic reports are no longer things of the future but necessities of the present. The College is proud of the major steps forwards taken in this area in 2013 and we will build on these forms of communications in 2014.

Our College Captains were again outstanding, Amelia Down, Brent McGrath, Cassidy Sellings and Tim Day. They moved into their roles from day one by running the very first assembly for the school year and then representing the College at the various ANZAC Day services held in the Echuca area. They worked hard to organize the Year 12s on their last day and they did a great job promoting the College at various events around Echuca. I would also like to acknowledge the time and effort our Assistant Principals put into the students, staff and College community. Mrs. Gould and Mr. Strachan really are the linchpins that hold the College together and much of their work is not seen or acknowledged. 'Diversity is Our Strength' at Echuca College and I'm proud that we embrace this concept and that our curriculum demonstrates our ability to cater for all, while producing champions, achievers and personal best in our students.

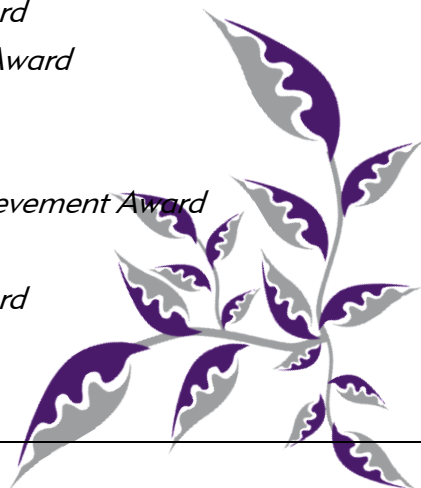

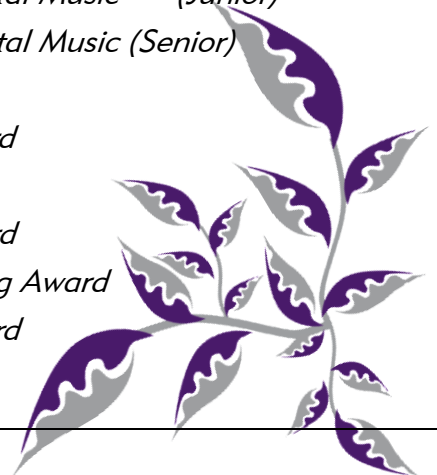

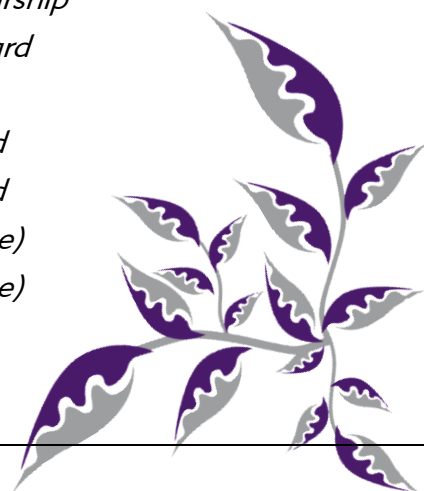
